Description of the department:					
<p>With more than 6,500 employees, the Maastricht University Medical Center+ (MUMC+) is one of the largest employees in the South of The Netherlands. The research- and education department and the quality of health care are famous in the whole world. MUMC gives employees who have the ambition to excel a chance.</p> <p>The department of paediatrics of the Maastricht University Medical Centre+ provides top-clinical care and academia in the heart of Europe.</p> <p>Within the division of Paediatric Intensive Care, we have one position vacant for a paediatric intensivist or paediatric anaesthetist with a completed training in the paediatric intensive care.</p> <p>The paediatric intensive care comprises 8 operational beds and one emergency bed, with over 500 admissions per year. Any critically ill child between 4 weeks and 18 years of age can be admitted to this multidisciplinary ward. The region of adherence is the south-eastern part of The Netherlands with a population of over 1.6 million inhabitants. All paediatric specialties are represented in the MUMC+ except paediatric cardiac surgery.</p>					

The staff formation of the PICU is 7 paediatric intensivists (6,5 formation) and one paediatrician in training for intensivist.

The PICU of the MUMC+ has an active inter-hospital retrieval team.

Topics are paediatric procedural sedation and analgesia (PSA), acute and chronic respiratory insufficiency including home ventilation.

Topics in research are in the field of inflammatory respiratory disease, PAS, upper airway obstruction and the acute care of critically ill children in general hospitals.

The PICU is part of the department of Paediatrics of the MUMC+.

Job description:

You are working in a team of enthusiastic paediatric intensivists.

With this team, you are responsible for the care of critically ill children and children with chronic respiratory problems admitted at the PICU and accessibility services.

You will have an important contribution in education and training of medical students, residents in paediatrics and paediatricians in training for intensivist.

You have scientific ambitions to play an active role in research in the field of paediatric intensive care.

You will contribute to the innovation of the department.

Job requirements:

You are registered within the EU as a paediatric intensivist or paediatric anaesthetist with proven training and skills in paediatric intensive care. Those who are finishing this training are also invited to reflect

You are speaking the Dutch language or are willing to learn Dutch.

At the time of your appointment you have to be enrolled in the BIG register and in the register of medical specialties of the RGS. You are registered as paediatric intensivist by the Dutch Association of Paediatrics (NVK).

It is recommended that you have a PhD or you have to complete a doctoral thesis during your appointment at Maastricht UMC+.

Besides an enthusiastic, energetic work-attitude and a sense of responsibility we are looking for a flexible, innovative and ambitious colleague to support our team. You should be able to work together with various other disciplines.

All staff who will be employed at the MUMC+ for more than one year must provide a Certificate of Conduct (VOG) before commencing employment.

Appointment:

This is an appointment for undetermined time, preceded by a probation period of 1 year. This is in accordance with the Collective Labour Agreement for Dutch University Medical Centres (CAO UMC), article 2.4.1., in a parttime appointment of 0.9 or 0.8 fte.

Working hours:

We offer you a job for a minimum of 40 and a maximum of 48 hours per week, excluding services, in case of a fulltime job.

You are expected to serve on the duty roster during evenings, weekends and bank holidays.
