Applications are invited for a10 Session/ PA Consultant Paediatric Intensivist job to join the PICU team based at University Hospital of Wales, Cardiff.

Cardiff Paediatric Critical Care Unit (PCCU) is based in the new Children's Hospital for Wales which was opened in March 2015. Cardiff Paediatric intensive care unit (PICU) has 6 beds and is the only children's intensive care unit located within Wales and accepts children requiring intensive care from all of mid and South Wales. Cardiff paediatric high dependency unit (HDU) has 4 beds and provides high dependency care to all the tertiary specialities housed in the children's hospital for Wales

Retrieval, education and audit both for the Unit and as part of the clinical network are major parts of the service and consultants are expected to participate fully in their delivery with part of this post being based at WATCh (Wales and West Acute Transport for Children) headquarters in Bristol delivering children from the region into both Cardiff and Bristol PICUs.

This appointment comes at an exciting time as we prepare to expand our PICU bed base to meet rising demand and become a major trauma centre.

Cardiff and Vale University Health Board is recognised as a teaching centre of excellence in a wide range of clinical services.

Academic interests will be encouraged; research and teaching in collaboration with Cardiff University's School of Medicine will be expected.

Although this post is full-time, consideration will be given to applicants who require flexible working arrangements.

Applicants should either be on the Specialist Register for Paediatric Intensive Care or be a Specialist Registrar within six months of their expected date of receipt of a CCT / CESR(CP) at the time of interview.
